## Wild Eyes Cabins.

## Activities

In addition to the great fishing and hunting, there are lots of other things to see and do in the area.

**Sightseeing:** Searching out and watching all the wild life in the area usually tops the list. Up the road, Red lake and Madsen are both historic gold mining areas – Red Lake is also known for its seaplane base.

**Golfing:** Just up the road is the Ear Falls Golf & Country Club, it is a 9 hole golf course carved from the northern boreal forest of spruce and pine. The Red Lake Area Golf & Country Club is the most northerly 18-hole golf course in Ontario.

**Shopping:** Although you'll have to drive a bit, there are many stores to buy souvenirs, as well as items for your stay. There are numerous quaint little restaurants in the towns both north and south of the camp.

**Festivals:** The touring region slightly north of our camps is well known for its Festivals! The annual Norseman Floatplane Festival at Red Lake in July is a celebration of Red Lake's Aviation History.

## THE CAMPS

### Lost Bay Resort – the Headquarters

Lost Bay resort is situated on the east end of Cliff Lake on a quiet bay. We are a drive-to resort just one half mile off the highway. There are two varieties of House keeping accommodations:

Classic Canadian cabins with cozy knotty pine interiors. Each cabin has an indoor washroom, shower, fridge, stove, oven, bed linens, dishes and cooking utensils. Classic Cabins are furnished with a variety of double, single and bunk beds.

Executive Timber Frame homes are very fashionable with all the amenities of a modern home. Situated right on the water with extra large decks and two big patio doors facing the lake, these deluxe units are unsurpassed in Northwestern Ontario. Executive Timber Frame Homes have two private bedrooms and a loft. There are a total of six separate beds, five queens, and one single, with a total sleeping capacity of eleven. In addition to all the usual amenities of the Classic Cabins, these Executive Homes have: two full baths, a dishwasher, a fireplace and desks and shelves in the bedrooms. The warm glow of the knotty pine interior and large timber frame posts and beams will please your eyes and enrich your stay in the Canadian Wilderness.

### Wild Eyes Outpost Camp

Wild Eyes Outpost Camp is on the northwestern end of Cliff Lake, far from civilization. It is accessible by boat from the Headquarters at Lost Bay Resort or by vehicle down a remote access road. There is a small log lodge to gather with friends and family. Large groups can use the kitchen and dining area in the lodge. Great swimming is provided for the kids on a safe gently sloping, sandy beach. The camp is protected from all but a welcome south wind. A remote, but quiet, generator provides electric power and most of the buildings are equipped with nostalgic gas lighting. The camp is equipped with central showers and toilets.

# Small Mouth Bass, White Fish, Perch

## Lake Trout

Lake Trout are plentiful in the main bodies of Cliff Lake. They're at depth during mid summer and in shallower areas in the spring. If you are a Trout fisherman, you'll be rewarded for your efforts at Cliff Lake.

## Small Mouth Bass

Regardless of conditions, Smallies are always available and they fight like they're three times bigger than they are. Because the lake is so clear, you can always find Smallies just by looking. They are abundant everywhere and will provide action for everyone.

## White Fish

Like trout, White Fish are found in the deeper zones feeding on Ciscoes. Like all the fish from Cliff Lake, which is cool, clear and pure, White Fish are excellent eating.

## Perch

Given the abundance and variety of all the other fish in Cliff and surrounding lakes not much time is typically spent fishing Perch. We do see big ones sporadically on a stringer of wall-eyes and occasionally someone comes in with a basket of them.

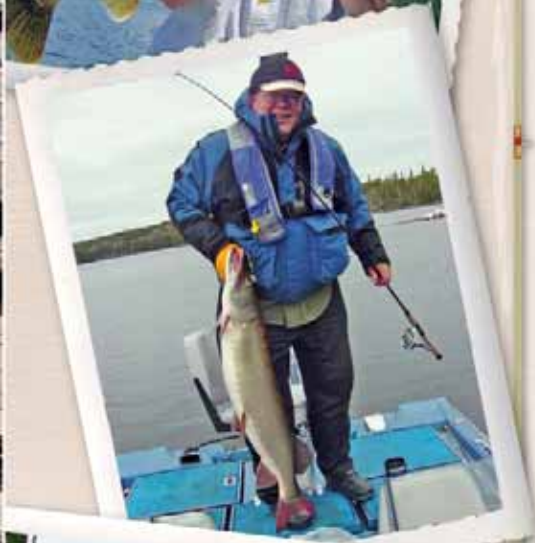
## Musky

Cliff Lake is full of giants, thanks to the conservation efforts practiced by our guests and others. It is not uncommon; actually likely, that you will see a musky or get a follow regardless what you are fishing for – perhaps even land one. If Musky is your quarry you'll be rewarded with lots of action for your efforts and expertise.



## Walleye

If your looking for a trophy, then Cliff Lake is the place to get it – they grow big here! If it's Walleye dinner or a shore lunch you desire, then spend a few hours on Cliff Lake early or late in the day or head over to the attached dark water lakes for action any time of the day.



## Northern

Like Musky, Cliff Lake has more than its share of big Northern. They are in the bays in the spring and then, as the year progresses, hiding in the endless structure existing in Cliff Lake. For non-stop action, or to keep the kids happy, cast the shallow bays, especially in the attached lakes for small but hard fighting Northern.

wind conditions, there is always a pleasant place to fish. The lake gains its name from the numerous magnificent cliffs that encompass its shoreline. Abundant rivers and streams enter the lake and provide excellent fish and game habitat. Because there are so few camps on Cliff Lake, fishing pressure is light and the fish grow large. Once away from camp you will likely spend hours, perhaps all day, on the water without seeing another boat. Fishing Cliff Lake is the closest you can get to a wilderness experience at a drive in camp.

#### **ATTACHED LAKES**

There is additional great fishing reached by boating up a navigable river to three additional classic Canadian "root beer" colored shallower lakes; Mystery, Evening and Twilight. Adding to the adventure you might have to pull a few sticks from a beaver dam to pass through.

#### **PORTAGE AND CACHE LAKES**

If you're looking for a truly rugged and remote Canadian wilderness fishing experience, where getting there is half the adventure, there are boats and motors available on five other cache lakes nearby. April, Beaton, Three Corner, Shultz and Pickerel Lakes are accessible by portage from Cliff Lake or by ATV or Jeep. Not recommended if you're afraid of solitude or intimidated by majestic beauty!

**Hiking:** Several trails lead out from Lost Bay Resort and wind their way up to the top of the rocky hills and cliffs surrounding the lake - take a compass along. There is blueberry picking in season and always-beautiful views overlooking the lakes from the top.

**ATV or Jeep Trails and roads:** The autumn of the year is a great time for using the trails that abound in and around the camps. The remoteness of the Wild Eyes Outpost is especially advantageous for ATV's. As always, be respectful of others in camp and tread lightly as the ground is soft and plants have a short growing season to heal.

**Canoeing and Kayaking:** Silently gliding through the bays along the shoreline area will reveal the abundance of wildlife at Cliff Lake. Looking down expect to see fish, turtles, beavers, muskrats. On the surface of the lake, abundant loons, some with a chick or two, ducks and gulls of many varieties. Soaring high, visible most of the time, are the American Bald Eagles that populate the area. Guests many times report seeing a moose along shore, sometimes swimming.
